VIRTUAL Broadway Bound-(multiple sessions/age group) During the week the students will work with the Sky team in music theater "core" topics. Sing, Dance, Act. Each day will also include a lunch break and a daily mystery master classes taught by celebrity guest, professionals or masters in the field (see masterclass list to see our current summer offerings)

STUDIO Broadway Bound- Each week, students will work with the Sky team learning musical theater "core" topics. Sing, Dance, Act. Each day will include a lunch break and daily mystery master classes taught by professionals or masters in the field (see masterclass list to see our current summer offerings) - This program will be available through Westborough Community Education, and at The SkyRise Studio.

Virtual Cabaret- Are you a music theater fanatic? This is the program for you! The students will start with an opening meeting, then break up in to 4 separate zoom rooms. These rooms will include: individual or small group training in singing, dancing, and acting. Each day includes a lunch “hang out” and other group/team building exercises. At the end of the two weeks, The students will have learned and perfected their own solo, monologue, and movement/acting piece to be performed LIVE!

Virtual Musical - Written by Beat By Beat Press.

"In this first-of-its kind musical, each actor will receive a 1-2 minute scene/song to rehearse, video record, and upload. When all the videos are played in order, they tell the hilarious story. The students will work in small groups or have individual training with multiple SkyTeam members throughout the week.

IN HOUSE programs

How are you keeping the kids safe, and what safety protocols are you following?

Will my child have to wear a mask the entire duration of the program?

We are providing every child who comes to the studio or any in person program with their own clear face shield that will be worn during their time in the program. They will take these home and bring back each day. We will sanitize them upon arrival. During lunch they can remove the shield to eat, as we will be spacing everyone accordingly. If your child doesn't want to wear a clear face shield, we will require them to wear a mask when they are within 6' of another person. We have handmade masks for sale for \$5.00 at the studio.

What will pick up and drop off look like?

Drop off- We will have everyone drop off their child at the start of our walkway, they will then follow our entrance protocol (sanitation station, and temp scans) There will also be a brief questionnaire for parents each day to fill out.

Pick up- We ask that families wait in the marked pick up line at the entrance of the studio, and text when you are next in line to get your child. We will also discuss pick up procedures in more details as we get closer to the program start date.

How are you going to handle lunch time?

Lunch must be provided by each child (NUT FREE) We will be spacing out the kids at least 6 feet apart, and will be asked to wash their hands prior and after eating. We will also be sure that no-one is sharing food.

How many are going to be in the program?

Right now our STUDIO program is going to have 10 students and 2 staff members. Per the state guidelines and CDC we are able to have a total # of 12 in a group (As of June 5, 2020) this # may increase as time moves forward. We will notify you of any changes in our participant #'s

Will there be enough space to keep everyone 6' apart?

Yes, we have recently renovated our studio to open the footprint of our space. We will also be marking the floor where it is safe for our students to stand and arrows marked on the floor for directional movement.

Will you be going outside at all?

Oh yes! If it is nice out, we will have some of our classes outdoors. (weather permitting)

What do you do during your down time?

We are always having fun! When we aren't working on a masterclass or core topic- we are playing various theater games, outdoors or arts and crafts. We may throw in a surprise movie!

Is there an extended day?

We are not offering extended day at this time.

Will there be a performance?

There is not a performance for the Broadway Bound programs as this is set up more for training in the arts. There WILL be a performance for the Virtual Cabaret, Virtual Musical, High School Musical, and Grow Bean Grow. All productions this summer will be filmed and produced into a movie for later viewing, or Performed LIVE virtually.

Are you allergy safe?

Yes, our facility is NUT free. And we require everyone to bring in a NUT free snack/lunch.

Are there snacks and water available?

We sell snacks and water for \$1

Do you have a refund policy?

At this time, and in agreement to you signing our summer release, we will not be offering refunds if you decide to withdraw from a program during the program or prior to the program.

What is ShowTime Express in the IN HOUSE Broadway Broad programs?

These are mini scenes and a song or two from a popular Broadway musical. The students will learn and memorize the script, then dress in costumes and perform the show LIVE for families to watch at home.

How do I use zoom?

There will be a link sent for the week of your class, and you can join by clicking the link. Downloading the APP on your device or computer is easiest.

Does my child have to attend everyday?

Yes, as this will help the child build their confidence, and strengthen their knowledge in the topics we are teaching. Especially if the child is in a program in which they are putting on a production at the end.

Does my child have to stay on Zoom to eat lunch?

While we think It's a great opportunity for the cast to talk and bond, we are not requiring students to stay on for lunch. We do however expect them to log back into the zoom for the next rehearsal period.

Will there be a performance for the VIRTUAL MUSICAL

Yes, we will be putting together all of the videos submitted by the students into a movie that will be available for later viewing post production. Digital copies will be emailed through GoogleDoc post production.

How will my child perform their act in the VIRTUAL MUSICAL

We will be coaching them on where to perform their scene/song, talk about lighting, sound, and background decor to help with the look of their scene.

Will there be a performance for Virtual Broadway Bound

There is not a performance for the Broadway Bound programs as this is set up more for training in the arts. There WILL be a performance for the Virtual Cabaret, Virtual Musical, High School Musical, and Grow Bean Grow. All productions this summer will be filmed and produced into a movie for later viewing, or Performed LIVE virtually.

How will the performance go for VIRTUAL CABARET

On July 17th the kids will come into the studio in Westborough at 11am, and we will space them out 6' apart and provide clear face shields for them to wear. They will stand in a rotation and wait for their act to be up to then step in front of the camera to perform LIVE. Once they get to the camera they can take off their shields and perform. There will also be a group number that will be pre-recorded and edited to make a music medley. Each student will learn and later perform 1-2 songs, movement or dance, and monologue for the performance.
